Information Confidential by Statute, Common Law or Constitutional Privacy.</b> The Attorney General will raise 552.101 exception for you even if you do not.□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.103. Litigation or Settlement Negotiations</b> where Governmental Body or Employee (as consequence of employment) is a Party. Applies to Civil and Criminal.□</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.102. Personnel information</b> in a personnel file that would be unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Employee has special right of access.□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.104. Competition or Bidding Information.</b>□</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.1081. Information Regarding Execution of Convict.</b>□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.105. Location or Price of Property.</b>¶                      □</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.1085. Sensitive Crime Scene Image.</b> sensitive crime scene image in the custody of a governmental body is confidential and a governmental body may not permit a person to view or copy the image except as provided. Applies to any sensitive crime scene image regardless of the date that the image was taken or recorded.□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.106. Legislative Documents:</b> a draft or working paper involved in the preparation of proposed legislation.¶                      □</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.109. Private Communications of an elected office holder</b> if would constitute invasion of privacy.□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.107. Attorney Client Privileged and Court Sealed Legal Matters.</b> Information that the attorney general or an attorney of a political subdivision is prohibited from disclosing because of a duty to the client under the Texas Rules of Evidence or the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct; or that a court by order has prohibited disclosure.*□</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.110. Confidentiality of trade secrets and Certain Commercial or Financial Information</b> if demonstrated that disclosure would cause substantial competitive harm.□</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.108. Law Enforcement, Corrections or Prosecutorial Information.</b> ¶                      □</p>

<p><b>Sec. 552.113. Geological or geophysical information</b> (logs, data, maps) ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.111. Agency Memoranda.</b> An interagency or intra-agency memorandum or letter that would not be available by law to a party in litigation with the agency. ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.114. Student Records</b> education records as that term is defined by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 or information in a record of an applicant for admission to an educational institution, including a transfer applicant. ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.112. Information Relating to Regulation of Financial Institutions or Securities.</b> ¶ ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.115. Birth and Death Records</b> ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.116. Audit Working Papers.</b> Working papers of a state auditor or state agency auditor, an institution of higher education, a county, a municipality, a school district, a hospital district, or a joint board operating under Transportation Code. ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.117. Certain Employee Information:</b> addresses, telephone numbers, SS numbers and personal family information of current or former officials or employees with written statement under 552.024 and various law enforcement and military personnel even without written statement. ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.122. Test Items.</b> Developed by an educational institution that is funded wholly or in part by state revenue or by a licensing agency or governmental body. ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.1175. Records and Personal Identifying Information of Certain Law Enforcement and Other Specific Officials.</b> Requires written election and applies to documents held by governmental body in any capacity (not just personnel files), no time limit — applies until rescinded. ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.125. Environmental Health and Safety Audits.</b> Any documents or information privileged under the Texas Environmental, Health, and Safety Audit. ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.1176. Information Maintained by the State Bar.</b> ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.144. Working Papers and Electronic Communications of Administrative Law Judges.</b> State Office of Administrative Hearings judges. ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.118. Official Prescription Program information.</b> ¶ ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.146. Communications with Assistant or Employee of Legislative Budget Board.</b> ☐</p>
<p><b>Sec. 552.119. Certain Photographs of Peace Officers,</b> the release of which would endanger the life or physical safety of the officer. ☐</p>	<p><b>Sec. 552.147. Social Security Numbers.</b> The social security number of a living person is excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021, but is <u>not confidential under this section</u> and this section does not make the social security number of a living person confidential under another provision of this chapter or other law. *** ☐</p>
